The Club:

Founded in 1946 by Elisabeth Norgall from Frankfurt, the IWC is a non-profit association for women which is politically and religiously independent. The aim of the club is to join cultural and national diversities by encouraging members to get to know and develop an understanding for one another, thereby contributing to peace and friendship in the world.

The **IWC**, which currently numbers around 400 women from 50 nations, gives its members the opportunity to develop their ideas and abilities; to pursue mutual interests and to gain an insight into a variety of different cultures.

The **IWC** encourages members to participate in any of the multifarious Interest Groups organized by individual members which offer a variety of activities.

The **IWC** is committed to the community and social commitment plays a central role. Through our various working groups and donation projects, we have been supporting the Hohenwald senior citizen's home as well as the Mosaikschule for many years and, more recently, the MädchenbüroMilena e.V.

The Club-Life:

The official languages of the club are German and English.

Meetings: One of the pillars of club life is the monthly member's regular meeting at which guests are also welcome. These regular meetings include various supporting programs while members and guests enjoy a meal together, either lunch or dinner. The cost of the meal is paid by the participants.

Activities: From cultural trips, literature groups and museum visits to music events, just to name a few, the club offers its members a wide variety of activities The events of the various interest groups often take place in a private setting.

Elisabeth Norgall Award: One of the highlights of the club year is the presentation of the Elisabeth Norgall Award in memory of the founder of the IWC, Elisabeth Norgall. It is awarded each year in March to a woman who is recognized specifically for her charitable work related to the needs and problems of women, either in Germany or internationally.

Other highlights include the **Christmas Tea** in Frankfurt's Römer and the **International Friendship Party** in June, which concludes the annual fundraising marathon and our club year.
